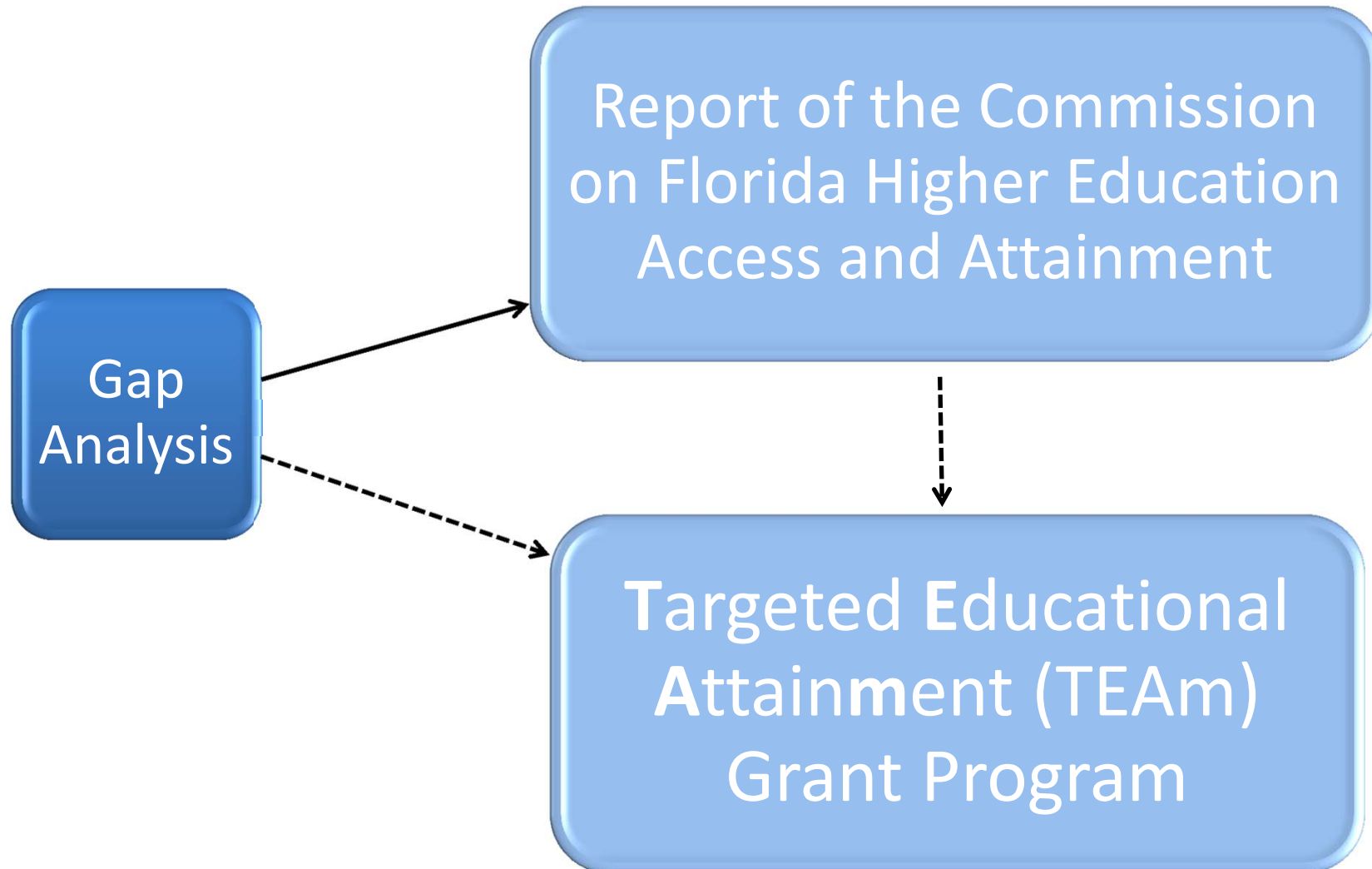

Monitoring and Reporting

- Access and Attainment Commission will provide oversight of grant program
- An Evaluation Committee will monitor grantees
- The grantee is required to report information twice a year through the 2017-2018 academic year:
 - Narrative Reports
 - Performance Metrics
 - Budget Documents
- Grantees will be required to follow completers into the workforce or further education.
