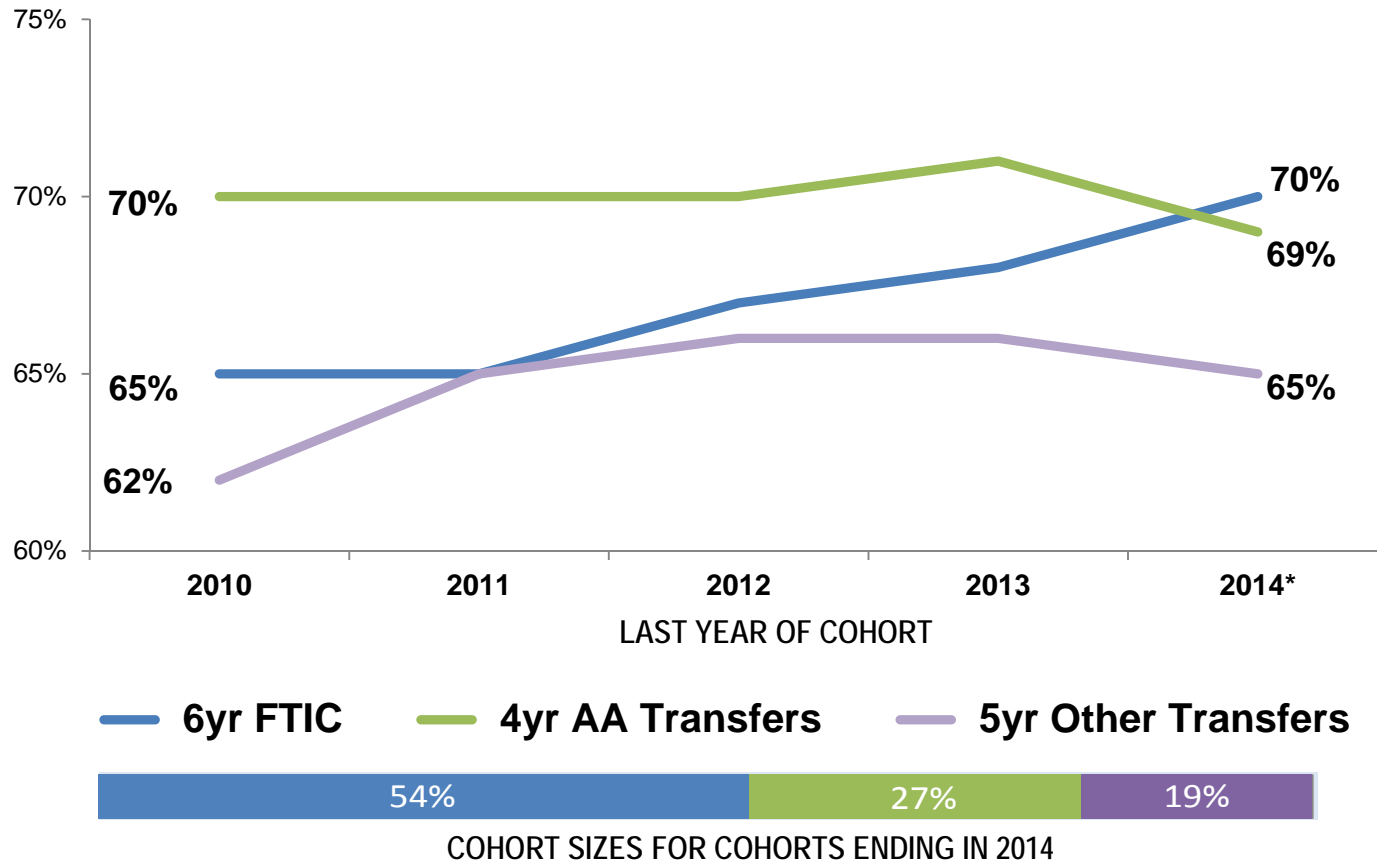

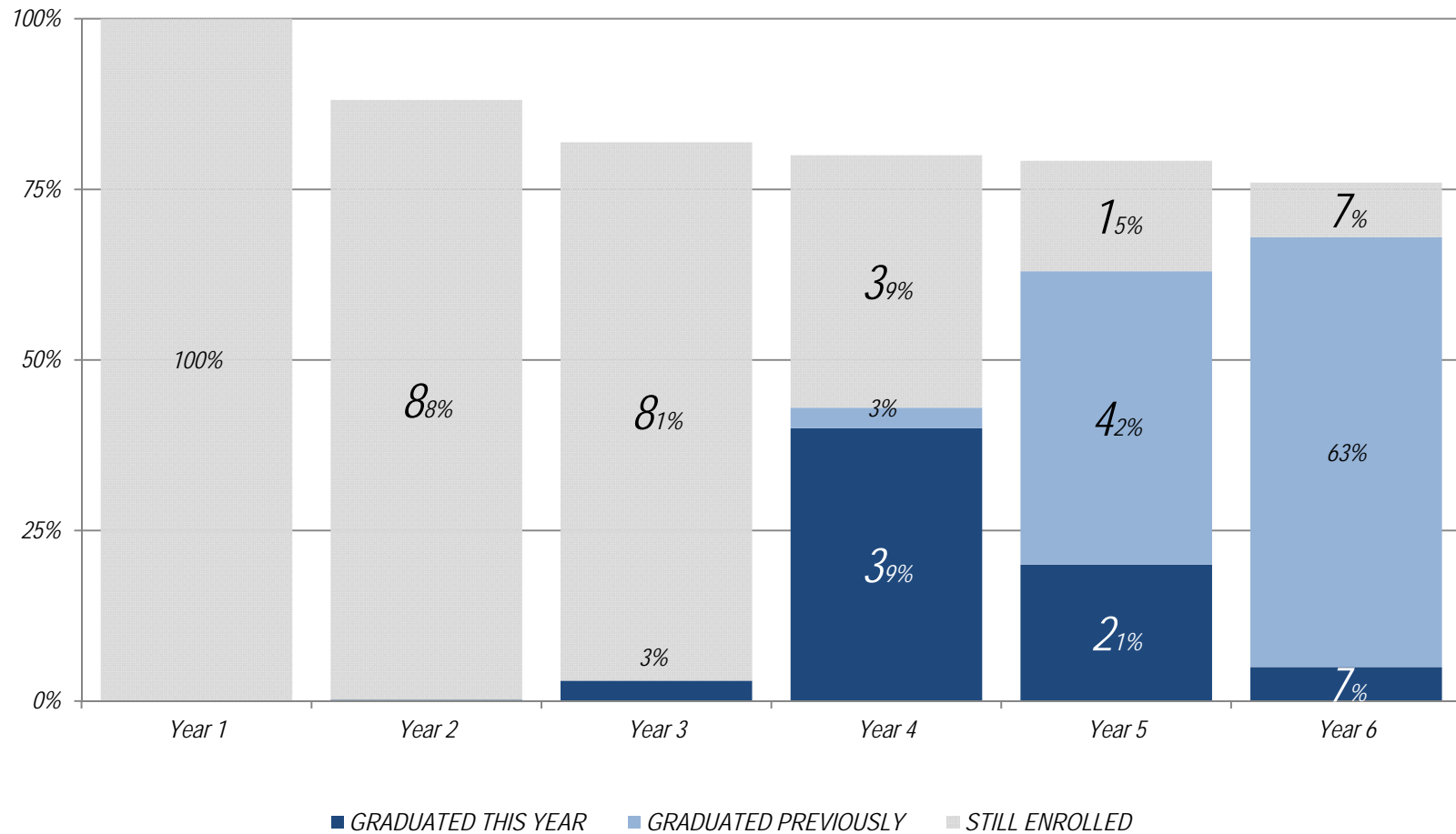

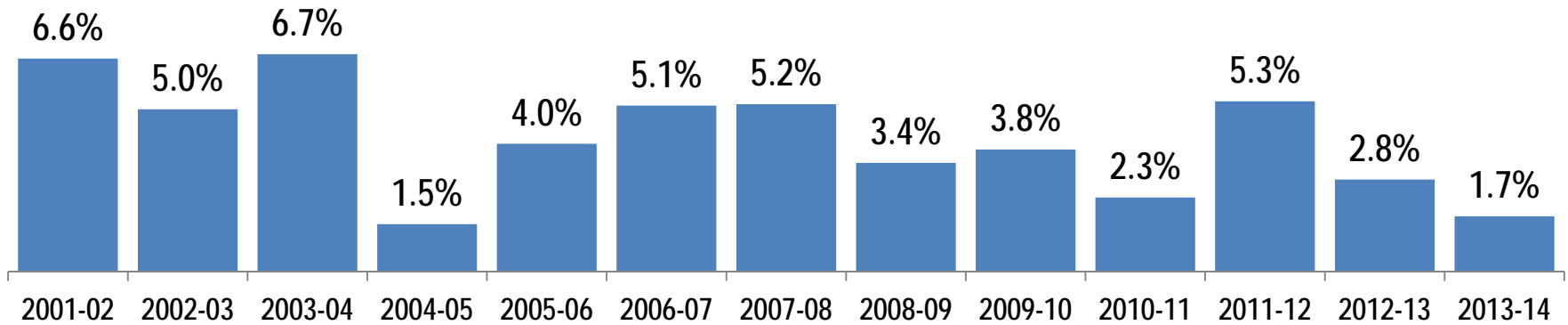

Annual Change in SUS Bachelor's Degrees



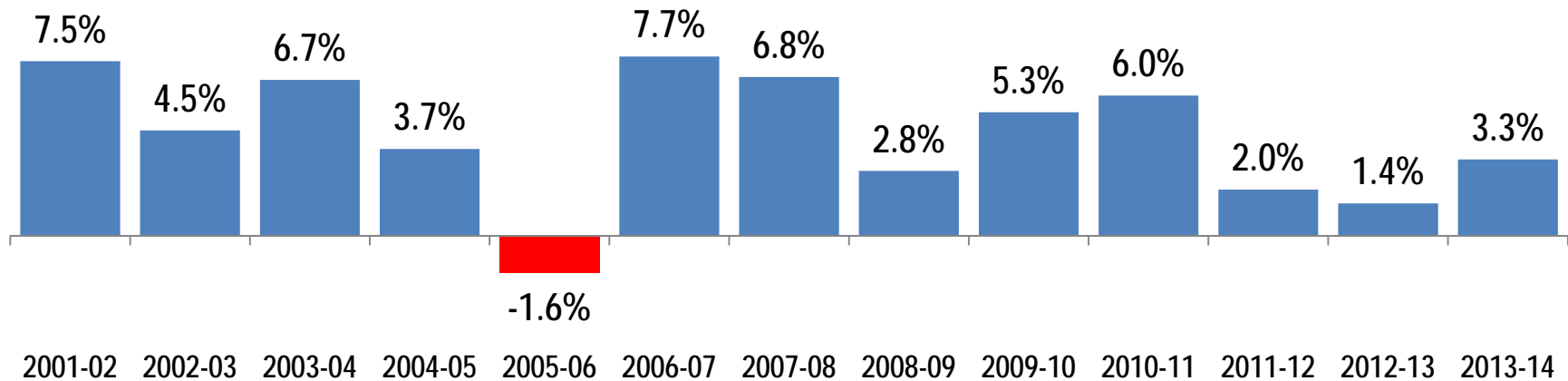

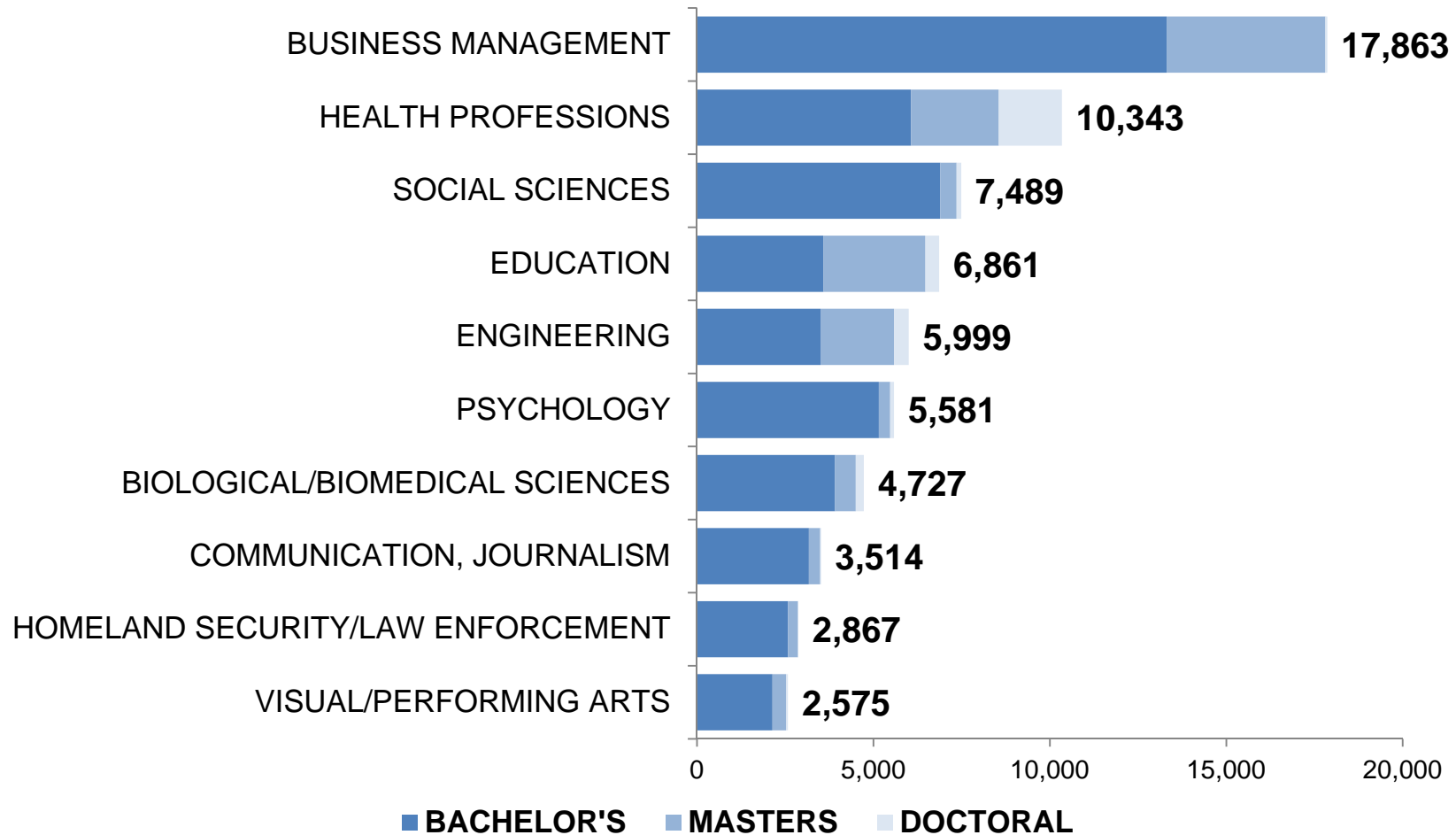
Annual Change in SUS Graduate Degrees

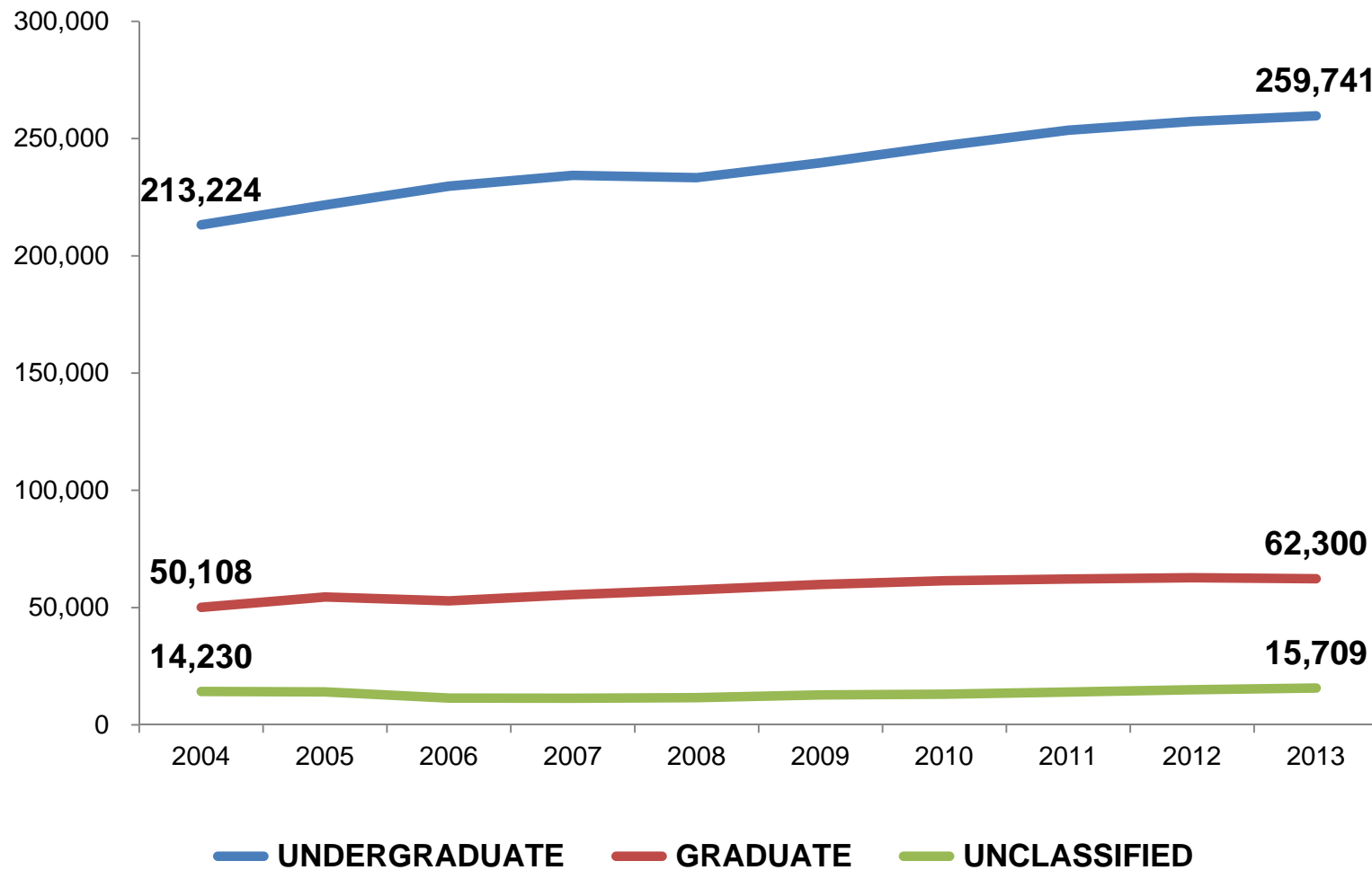

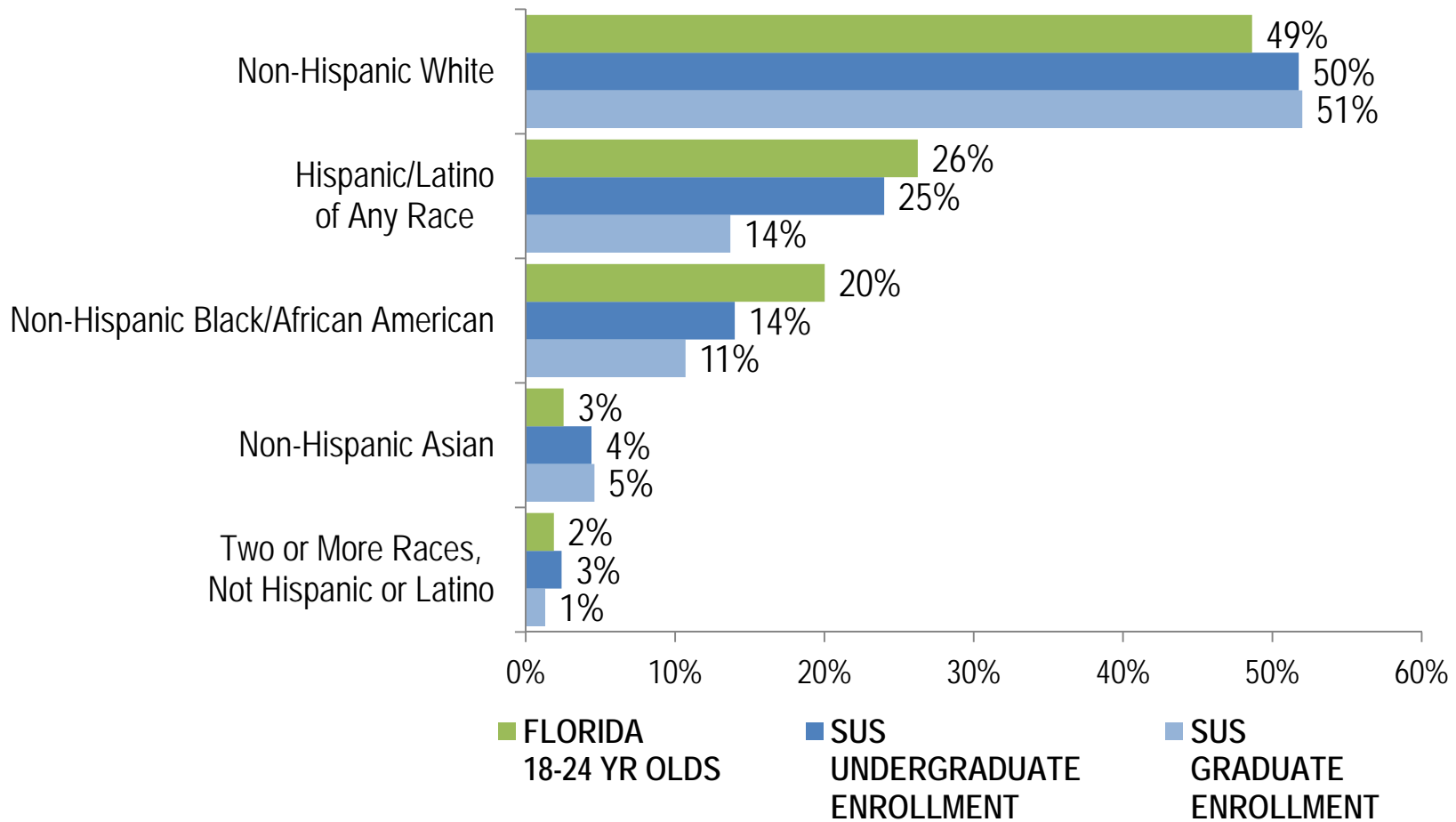


Fall Headcount Enrollment Trends





Enrollment Demographic Comparison: System & Florida

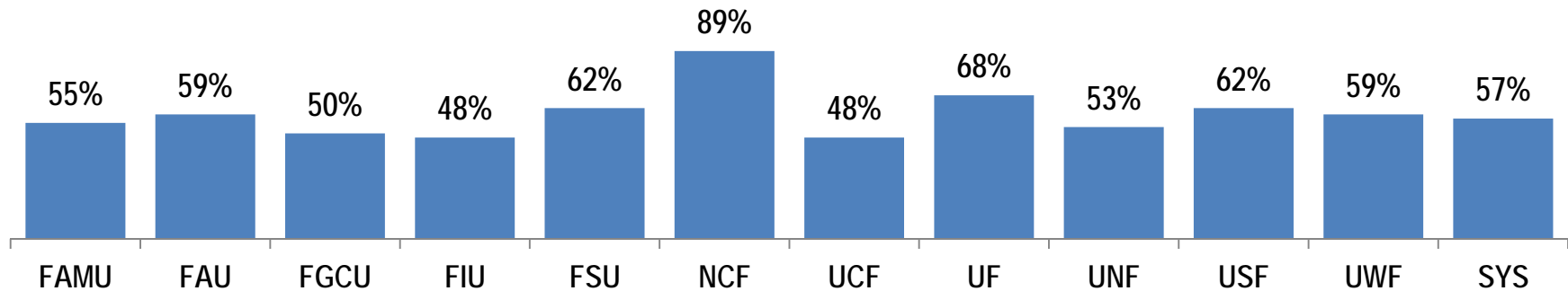
