BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Florida State University (FSU) is requesting the termination of the Ph.D. in Chemical Physics. The program has been suspended for new enrollments since Spring 2014 and currently has no students enrolled. No students or faculty will be adversely affected by this change.

The termination of this program was formally approved by FSU's Board of Trustees on October 9, 2015. If approved by the Board of Governors, the termination would become effective Spring 2016 with a phase-out term of Spring 2016.
