NOTICE OF PROPOSED NEW REGULATION

REGULATION NUMBER AND TITLE: 6.012 Access to Certain Electronic Library Resources by Accelerated Secondary Students

SUMMARY: Pursuant to section 1007.27, Florida Statutes, new Board of Governors Regulation 6.012, Access to Certain Electronic Library Resources, requires that accelerated secondary students have access to electronic library resources funded by the Florida Center for Library Automation (FCLA). FCLA shall host the webpage to allow public secondary schools to input required information, pursuant to a rule that will be adopted by the State Board of Education.

**6.012 Access to Certain Electronic Library Resources by Accelerated Secondary Students**

(1) Public secondary school students enrolled in the articulated acceleration programs specified in section 1007.27, Florida Statutes, shall be eligible to use electronic library resources funded by the Florida Center for Library Automation (FCLA).

(2) FCLA shall host the Florida Library Access – Pass for Accelerated Secondary Students (FLA PASS) webpage to allow public secondary schools to input required information, pursuant to State Board of Education Rule \_\_\_\_\_.
