\$ 39,100

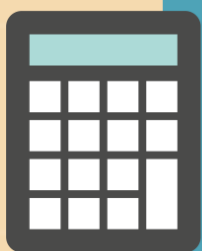
The minimum annual salary required for one adult to live in Florida
