BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On March 23, 2006, the Board of Governors approved requests for medical schools at Florida International University and the University of Central Florida. During the 2006 Legislative Session, both institutions received legislative authorization for the Colleges of Medicine, as approved by the Board of Governors.

In progress toward achieving preliminary accreditation by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education, each institution has hired a new medical school Dean. Florida International University has hired Dr. John A. Rock. The University of Central Florida has hired Dr. Deborah C. German. Board members will have the opportunity to meet the new College of Medicine Deans.
