


Work Plan System-Wide Issues

- Graduation & retention rates are increasing
- Enrollment & degree growth is slowing
 - but ... degrees awarded within the Programs of Strategic Emphasis are growing
- More External funding for R&D is needed
- Excess Hour rates are slowly decreasing
- System-wide academic program coordination is working




First-Time-in-College (FTIC) Six-Year Graduation Rates




Academic Progress Rate

National Comparison of Retention Rates Among 10 Largest States for Public 4-Yr Universities



Bachelor's Degrees Awarded Annually







National Comparison of Degree Production

5yr Growth Rate in Bachelor's Degrees



Percentage of 2012 Population (25-34) with at Least a Bachelor's Degree


Florida ranked 38th overall and LAST among the ten most populous states


Percentage of Bachelor's Degrees Awarded in Programs of Strategic Emphasis (PSE)

Graduate Degrees Awarded Annually






Percentage of Graduate Degrees Awarded in Programs of Strategic Emphasis



Research & Development Expenditures: State University System Trends


TOTAL R&D EXPENDITURES

(Dollars in Millions)





Research & Development Expenditures: Top 10 States & Percent External Funding


2012-13 R&D EXPENDITURES


PERCENT OF EXTERNAL FUNDING IN THE SUS






Bachelor's Degrees Without Excess Hours
