Purpose of the Credit-by-Exam & Work Experience Equivalencies





Allows students to receive postsecondary credit for performance on national exams

& prior experience



recommendations for exam scores & prior experience to be used across education systems

Set minimum course



Ensure smooth articulation & reduce unnecessary additional course requirements

- Faculty workgroup reviews student learning outcomes for assessments & work experience
- Recommendations for course equivalencies submitted to ACC
- List goes to Board of Governors & State Board of Education
- Published for use by SUS & FCS institutions

Credit-by-Exam Equivalencies

- Exams that meet a general education core course requirement were labeled as "core"
- Exams that meet the civic literacy competency requirement were labeled as "civics"
- No additional exams were approved for the list

- 3rd year of implementation
- In February 2024, the ACC recommended course equivalencies for 40 additional courses
- The list includes course equivalencies for academic credit for 187 courses
