SUBJECT: Public Notice of Approval to Repeal Board of Governors Regulation 8.004, Academic Program Coordination

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Consider approval to repeal Board of Governors Regulation 8.004, Academic Program Coordination.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors Regulation 8.004, Academic Program Coordination, outlines two specific components of academic program coordination. The first section outlines the role of the Council of Academic Vice Presidents (CAVP) and the CAVP Academic Coordinating Group (CAVP ACG) to ensure collaboration and coordination of academic programs across the State University System. The second section of the regulation outlines requirements for offering academic programs at education sites that are not part of the main campus or additional approved campuses.

Board staff propose repealing Regulation 8.004. The requirement for reviewing academic programs by CAVP and CAVP ACG has been incorporated into Regulation 8.011, Academic Degree Program Coordination and Approval, to better organize the steps in the program approval process. Board staff proposed an amendment to Regulation 8.009, Educational Sites, to incorporate provisions from Regulation 8.004 that relate to education sites. The Board will consider the public notice of intent to amend this regulation at the June meeting. As a result of incorporating the provisions of Regulation 8.004, this regulation is no longer needed.

The Board approved the public notice of intent to repeal this regulation at the meeting on March 27, 2024. No public comments were received and this regulation is ready for final approval to repeal.
