#### PROPOSED COMMITTEE ACTION

Validate the completed Educational Plant Survey of University of Florida.

## **AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION**

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution; Sections 1013.03 and 1013.31, Florida Statutes.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

An Educational Plant Survey (EPS) is required at least once every five (5) years for all public universities, per ss. 1013.03 and 1013.31, F.S. At the request of the University of Florida (UF), Board staff helped coordinate and facilitate the EPS two-phase multimonth-long process, as well as help ensure statutory requirements were satisfied.

Board staff participated on the EPS Team, which included volunteers from Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University, Florida Gulf Coast University, University of Central Florida, University of North Florida, and University of West Florida.

The EPS report validates UF's current inventory of education & general (E&G) space, and it assesses future space needs based on a 5-year projection of full-time equivalent (FTE) student enrollment growth. Based on this assessment, the Survey Teams provides recommendations supporting certain university proposed capital projects. The EPS report covers the period from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2029. An overview of UF's projected total need for E&G space is reflected below.
