



FTIC 4-Year Graduation Rate History of Goals & Improvement




The System has improved 23% pts since 2011



PBF 4: FTIC 4-Year Graduation Rate (Full-Time Only)








KPI 14: Licensure Exam Pass Rate 2024 Summary








