PROPOSED COMMITTEE ACTION

Consider approval of Public Notice of Intent to Repeal Board of Governors Regulation 10.014, Academic Infrastructure and Support Organizations.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors Regulation 10.014, Academic Infrastructure and Support Organizations outlines the provisions and procedures of these entities, including establishment, reporting requirements, and termination as recommended by the Council of Academic Vice Presidents (CAVP) and upon approval of the Board.

Board staff proposes repealing Regulation 10.014 because the two entities subject to this regulation are being reclassified as university centers to allow for operational flexibility and provide opportunities to receive federal funding. The two entities, the Florida Institute of Oceanography and University Press, are included in the proposed amendment to Regulation 10.015. Regulation 10.014 is also not required by Florida Statutes.

If approved by the Academic and Student Affairs Committee and the Board of Governors, the notice of intent to repeal will be available for public comment for 14 days. If no concerns are raised during that time, the repeal of the regulation will come before the Board of Governors for final approval at the next meeting.

Ms. Emily Sikes, Interim Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs, will provide an overview of the rationale for repealing this regulation.
