SUBJECT: Public Notice of Approval to Repeal Board of Governors Regulation 9.018 Charity Racing Day Proceeds

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approve the repeal of Regulation 9.018.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7(d), Florida Constitution; Board of Governors Regulation Development Procedures; section 550.0351 F.S.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This regulation is being repealed because it is no longer needed. Charity racing days are authorized in section 550.0351, Florida Statutes, to allow horseracing, jai alai, and previously dog racing permitholders to hold scholarship days in addition to regular racing days. State Universities are qualified beneficiaries of proceeds collected from charity performances. The Board of Governors has not received any additional charity racing day proceeds for distribution to the universities since 2018. If funds are received, they will be disbursed pursuant to statute.

The Board approved the public notice of intent to repeal this regulation at the June 28, 2024 meeting. No public comments were received.
