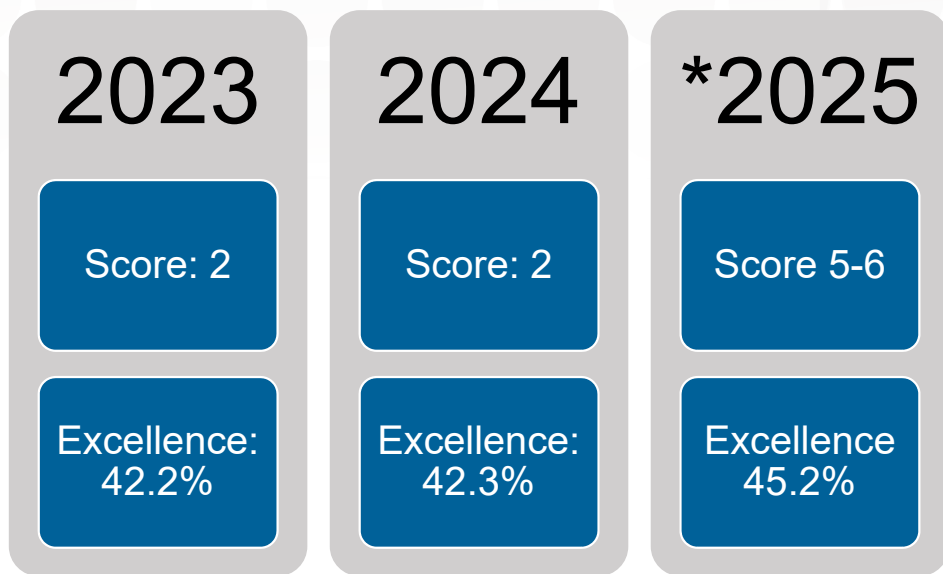

Four-Year Graduation Rate (FTIC)



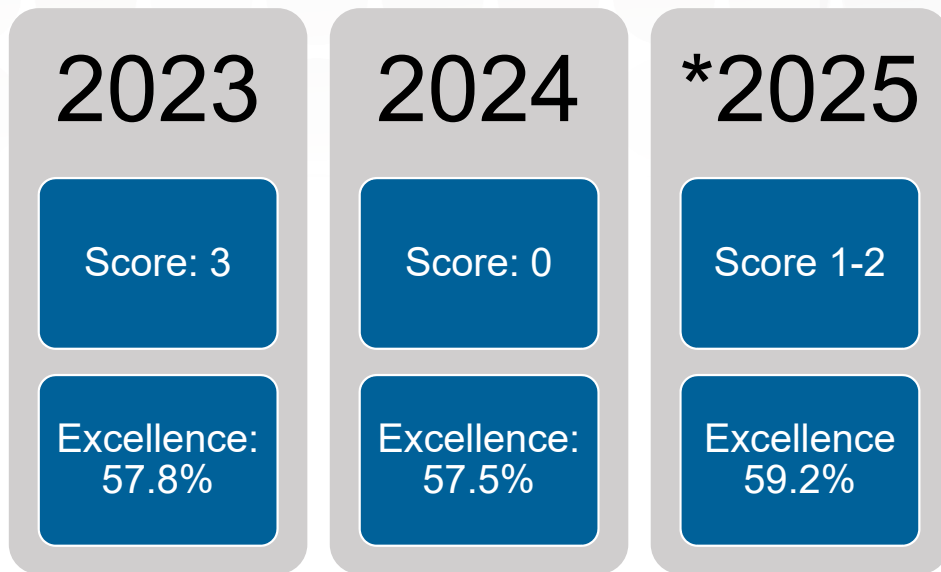

Three-Year Graduation Rate AA Transfer Students



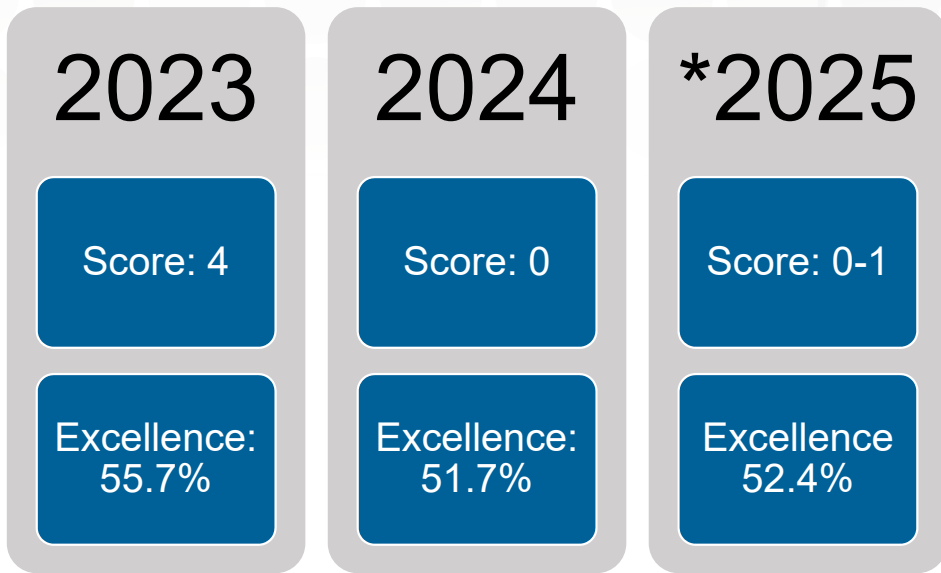

Six-year Graduation Rate Pell Grant Recipients



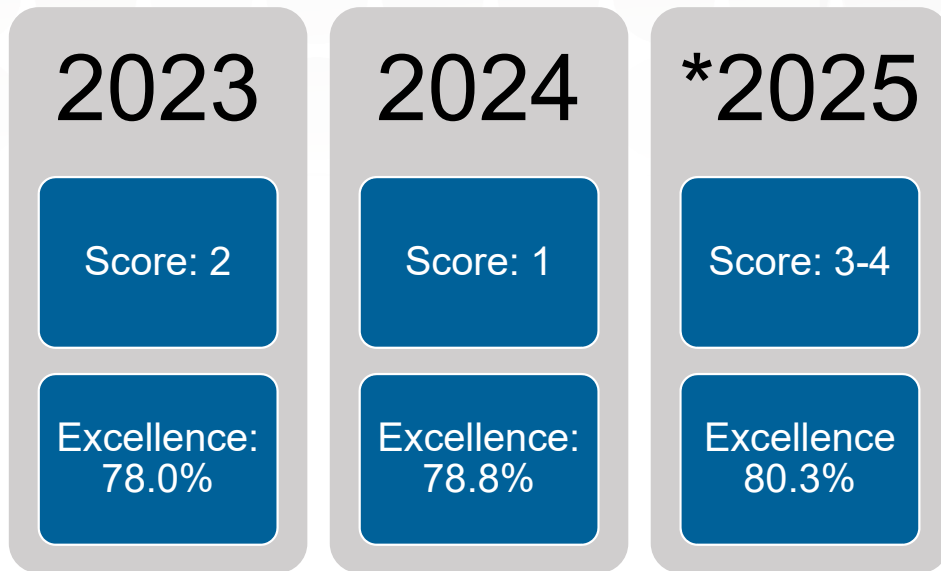

- Increase timely filing of accurate FAFSA applications and outreach to students in rural counties and/or from low-income backgrounds
- Increase employee professional development
- Create an employee resource course
- Implement Slate student success software for targeted interventions
