# Regulation 8.006 Civic Literacy

## **Regulation 8.006**

### Purpose

Defines methods for students to meet statutory requirement for civic literacy







Implement legislative changes to section 1004.6496, Florida Statutes

Add AMS X010 Civil Discourse & the American Political Order to meet the civic literacy course requirement

Students will have more course options




## Regulation 8.003 Textbook & Instructional Materials Affordability & Transparency

## **Regulation 8.003**

## Purpose

To establish transparency & affordability policies for course materials





Enhance transparency for the selection of textbook & instructional materials

• Requires universities to establish a process for approval & adoption of course materials

Faculty or instructors attest that they have reviewed all required instructional materials for each course they teach each semester

Ensure that all materials are reviewed before they are used for courses



Clarify definitions, update inventory, & streamline reporting requirements


- Updates definitions to provide clarity on categories
