Civic Literacy

Regulation 8.006



Purpose

Defines methods for students to meet statutory requirement for civic literacy



Impetus for Action

Implement legislative changes to section 1004.6496, Florida Statutes



Proposed Amendment

Add AMS X010 Civil Discourse & the American Political Order to meet the civic literacy course requirement



Impact on Institutions

Students will have more course options

Regulation 8.003



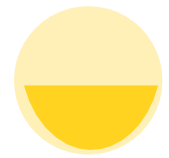
Purpose

To establish transparency & affordability policies for course materials



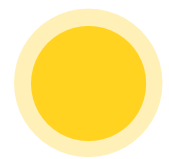
Impetus for Action

Enhance transparency for the selection of textbook & instructional materials



Proposed Amendment

- Requires universities to establish a process for approval & adoption of course materials
 - Faculty or instructors attest that they have reviewed all required instructional materials for each course they teach each semester
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Impact on Institutions

Ensure that all materials are reviewed before they are used for courses

10.015 Institutes and Centers	Amendment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Removes criteria for evaluations of centers & institutes & timeline for reporting Removes Board of Trustees required report
10.014 Academic Infrastructure & Support Organizations	Repeal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reclassifies 2 organizations as centers & institutes to allow for additional flexibility
8.007 Articulation	Amendment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Removes the required biennial review of each 2+2 Enhancement Program using the required rubric
8.010 Common Prerequisites	Repeal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Merges applicable language into 8.007
8.013 Specialized Admissions	Amendment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Removes the requirement for universities to document the need for specialized admissions each year (renewal process in place)

Regulations 10.015 & 10.014



Purpose

Establishes categories, approval requirements & reporting requirements for institutes and centers



Impetus for Action

- Clarify definitions, update inventory, & streamline reporting requirements
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Proposed Amendment

- Updates definitions to provide clarity on categories
 - Modifies reporting requirements & inventory maintenance
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Impact on Institutions

- Universities will be required to maintain a list of active institutes & centers on their public websites



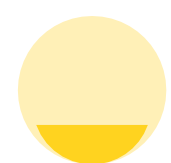

Regulations 8.007 & 8.010



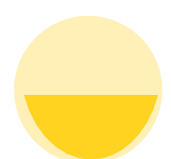
Purpose

Provides a framework for statewide articulation



Impetus for Action

- Implement a legislative change to section 1007.25, Florida Statutes
 - Incorporate 8.010 with 8.007
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Proposed Amendment

- Recognizes the Specialized AA Degree
 - Changes the name to 2+2 Targeted Pathway Articulation Agreements
 - Modifies reporting to focus on student success
 - Incorporates 8.010 Repeals 8.010
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Impact on Institutions

- Process for articulation agreements for Specialized AA Degrees
- Reduces reporting requirements

Regulation 8.013



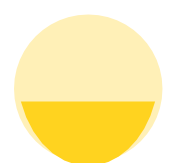
Purpose

Allows universities to establish additional criteria for admission to undergraduate programs



Impetus for Action

- Streamline annual reporting requirements & eliminate duplicative reporting
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Proposed Amendment

- Reduces annual reporting requirement to be admissions standards only
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Impact on Institutions

- Reduces reporting burden



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
