# SUBJECT: 2024-25 Linking Industry to Nursing Education (LINE) Fund Proposals

#### PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Consider approval of 2024-25 LINE Fund proposals.

## AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

During the 2024 session, the Florida Legislature allocated \$6 million to the State University System for the Linking Industry to Nursing Education (LINE) Fund for Fiscal Year 2024-25. The Board of Governors is responsible for administering the LINE Fund for the State University System, including evaluating and approving proposals to participate in the program. The LINE Fund is intended to incentivize collaboration between nursing education programs and healthcare partners and to meet local, regional, and state workforce demand by recruiting faculty and clinical preceptors, increasing the capacity of high-quality nursing education programs, and increasing the number of nursing education program graduates who are prepared to enter the workforce.

To participate in the program, section 1009.8962, Florida Statutes, requires that institutions have a nursing education program that meets or exceeds a first-time passage rate on the National Council of State Boards of Nursing Licensing Examination of at least 75 percent for the prior year based on a minimum of 10 testing participants. Subject to available funds, for every dollar a healthcare partner contributes to an institution, the fund shall provide a dollar-for-dollar match to the participating institution for approved proposals. Funds may be used for student scholarships, recruitment of additional faculty, equipment, and simulation centers to advance high-quality nursing education programs throughout the state. Universities cannot use the funds for the construction of new buildings. At the September 18, 2024 meeting, the Board authorized \$5,008,435 of funds to be distributed for 18 different proposals, leaving \$991,565 remaining for another allocation.

If approved by the Strategic Planning Committee, the LINE proposals will be forwarded to the full Board for consideration.
