Background



Section 1009.8962, Florida Statutes

Linking Industry to Nursing Education (LINE) Fund

- Incentivize collaboration between nursing education programs & healthcare partners
- The Board of Governors is charged with evaluating & approving program proposals
- Provides a dollar-for-dollar match for contributions from healthcare partners

Allowable Uses of LINE Funds

Section 1009.8962, Florida Statutes











Funds may **not** be used for the construction of new buildings

The Legislature allocated **\$6 million** in possible matching funds for the LINE Program this year



18 proposals were approved from 8 institutions during the first round



\$991,565 remained available for allocation
