Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution; Section 1001.705(2)(g), Florida Statutes

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 1001.705(2)(g), Florida Statutes requires the Board of Governors to adopt a strategic plan for the State University System of Florida. The current strategic plan expires at the end of 2025.

The Board of Governors began the process of updating its strategic plan in March of 2024. The Strategic Planning Committee discussed components of the new plan at each of its seven meetings in 2024. These meetings included discussions on mission and vision, strategic priorities, initiatives, and metrics and goals. The universities also collaborated with the Board on the development of this updated plan. From June through September, a steering committee made up of university presidents, staff, and external stakeholders met to provide input on the key strategic priorities for the plan. Board staff worked with key university groups across the System to get feedback on metrics and priorities.

The 2030 Strategic Plan includes five key strategic priorities. The plan includes initiatives, metrics, and goals to support these priorities. Ms. Emily Sikes, Vice Chancellor of Academic and Student Affairs, will present the highlights of the new plan.

If approved by the Strategic Planning Committee, this item will be forwarded to the full Board for consideration.
