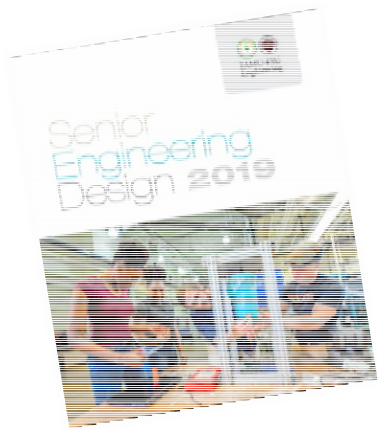

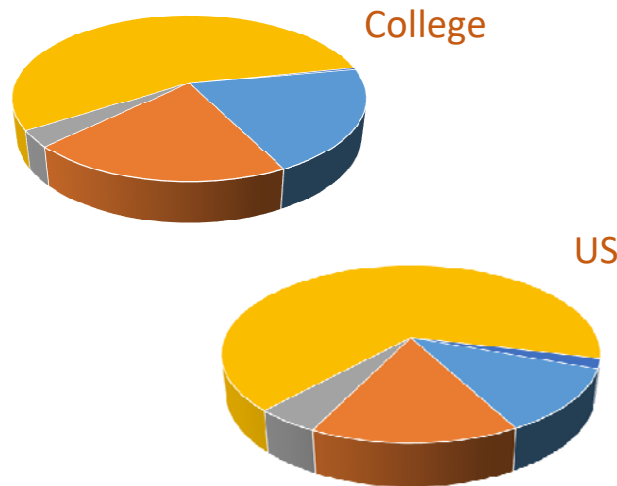

Recent accomplishments

Comparisons since 2016

- Up 19 points in *US News* rankings over two years
- Annual external research expenditures up 44% to \$28.3M
- 21% increase in PhD enrollment
- 500 graduates each year
- Most diverse engineering school in the nation
- #4 producer of African-American engineering PhD's
- Third largest number of African American faculty in engineering
- 28% female student population



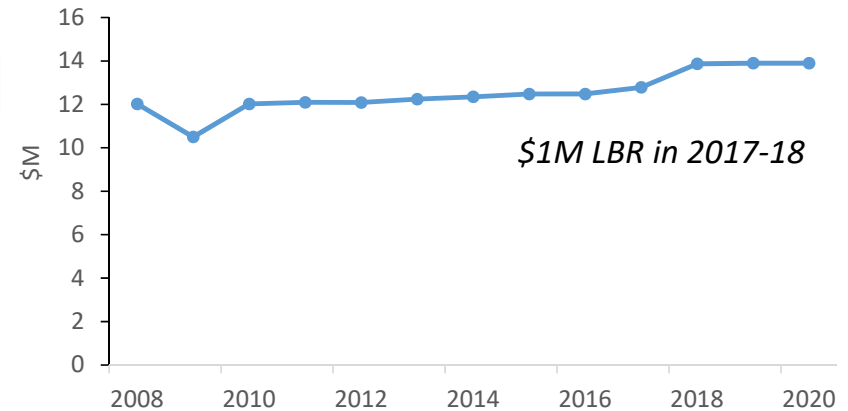

Resources needed to fuel our future success: LBR for \$6.5M

- Additional faculty \$1.3M
- Research support for faculty \$2.5M
- Support for undergraduate student success \$1.37M
- Strengthening graduate student programs \$640K
- Faculty retention and vitality \$690K

We also need additional space (Building C) approved by a 2017 Educational Plant Survey to address current student demand
